The program is requesting to move \$600 from Newspaper Adv (Line 13) to Answering Service (Line Item 3). The program must provide a 24/7 line for tipsters to call in anonymous tips. The program has experienced higher call volumes and needs to provide funds to cover projected costs in this area. The program is requesting to move \$1,440 from Cell Phone Tip Coor (Line 6) and \$1,000 from Newspaper adv (line 13) to Television Advertising Line 15 to cover projected costs for the duration of the grant year in order to maintain an advertising outlet that reaches app 123,000 households. The program is requesting to move \$400 from Travel (line 73) to Cellular Phone (Line 46). The program has experienced an increase in the cellular phone expense and funds are needed to over the expense of the program cell phone to receive general information calls from the public. Impact con't

By moving \$7,000 to the Wanted Advertising line item, the program will be able to secure advertising in an outstanding warrant tabloid that will provide coverage in 61,500 printed, circulated copies, (48 pages – stitched and trimmed tab on 55" paper) 200,000 web impressions and Ocala.com home page visibility for 30 days. Historically, the wanted types of publications have generated increase tips that have aided law enforcement in successfully apprehending wanted individuals. There are over 6,000 outstanding warrants in Marion County at this time.
