

Cyber Sense 5 of 7

Attorney General Bill McCollum: Umm, there are here are four pictures. Can you pick the bad guy out of these pictures or the bad guys there may be more than one. Let's start up here on the upper left. How many of you think this is a bad guy? Raise your hand, how many of you think that is a bad guy? Okay, put them down. Let's go up here on the upper right, how many think that's a bad guy? Okay about the same number. How about the one to the lower right corner? Oh give even more people think he's a bad guy, and the lower left over there? How many think he's a bad guy? Alright let's take the next slide and you're going to see who all these people are. Well 3 of the 4 are bad guys, but the one up on the left is our chief investigator, Chuck McMullen. He is in the Cyber Crime Unit. Actually Chuck is the one who goes undercover and you know what Chuck did in Jacksonville when we opened our Cyber Crime Office couple months ago? Chuck said to me and I said to the press, Chuck can go online and pretend to be a 15 years old girl or boy and in less than 10 minutes he's going to get solicited for sex. He went online and in less than one minute he was solicited for sex and in less than five minutes he was solicited by four different people. And he didn't do any special and that was like 10 o'clock in the morning on a school morning like this. Okay, these are let's go back again let go back to those people just one more time. This fellow over her on the right was arrested. He is a regional sale manager for Koors. The one on the lower right was a maintenance worker for a Hotel in Orlando. The one over there on the lower left umm was an attorney in North Carolina. All of them have been arrested in Florida. Let's go to the next slide. Let's look at these guys. Now how many of you think that the one over there to the left over there is a perpetrator, a bad guy, a child predator? Okay, put your hands down? How many about the one on the upper right? Yea, about the same not that many. About the one on the lower right down here, how many think he's a bad guy? How about the lower left, more of them? Okay let's go see who they are. Every one of these is a child predator. The fellow up on the left is a hardware salesman in Jacksonville. A karate in instructor in the upper right in Apopka in the orange county system. Apartment complex maintenance worker in the lower right and the one of the lower left was in the Navy and worked on worked on the Kennedy. That's the problem let me tell you. You can't look at these pictures and be sure who's a good guy or who's a bad guy. The other point is that child predators come in all walks of life, all races, all colors, all religions, either sex it doesn't matter. Hispanic, black, white, whatever, it doesn't matter. It doesn't matter whether you are a school teacher, they could be a principal of the school. I hate to say that Mr. Thompson, it could be a lawyer like me. They could be a doctor can be almost anything. We had an Assistant United States Attorney in North Florida that traveled to Michigan to meet and was arrested up there about a month ago and then committed suicide afterwards. An Assistant United States Attorney who was arrested. Could be a worker for Disney, could be anybody. Let's go to the next slide. Where, let's let's find out where where do people go online. We want to talk for a couple

minutes and we want to talk about screen names for a second. Won't even look at the screen. Where do you go online?

Child: (faintly speaking)

Attorney General Bill McCollum: Okay, where do you go online?

Child: MySpace

Attorney General Bill McCollum: MySpace. Where else beside those two? Where do you go online?

Child: (faintly speaking)

Attorney General Bill McCollum: Okay. Alright, they're not going to be able to hear you on TV. That's okay, where do you go online?

Child: (faintly speaking)

Attorney General Bill McCollum: Where do you go online? Facebook, we have a lot of people going online to different places. Ahh, who has a screen name they are willing to share? What's your screen name?

Attorney General Bill McCollum: careforone. What's your screen name?

Child: soccergirl23.

Attorney General Bill McCollum: soccergirl23.

Child: 323soccergirl.

Attorney General Bill McCollum: 323soccergirl. Okay, what other name anybody else wants to share one? Alright what's yours, okay? Now, let's take a look at who has a webcam. How many of you have a webcam, raise your hand? I'm not going to ask everybody but one of you in the back tell me what you use your webcam for.

Child: File share.

Attorney General Bill McCollum: Okay, what do you use your webcam for? One of you raised it, right over up here what do you use it for? Okay, what do you use it for? Somebody over here tell me what you use it for? Anybody tell me, what to u use it for?

Child: Talk to relatives.

Attorney General Bill McCollum: Talk to relatives, alright talk to relatives same thing. Alright, let's what do you use it for? No alright. Let's go the next slide. Now we've talked about the webcam and we talked about the names that you use. Look at the name that a lot of people use.

Some of you gave me a name similar to this, cheer4wildcats, leehigh15grl presumable girl, JAX and B Y 16, hot&spicy, sassysue, hot4hoops. Tell anybody tell me what's wrong with any one of those? Can anybody tell me? Tell me what's wrong with that?

Child: (faintly speaking)

Attorney General Bill McCollum: That's right the Wildcats can be the name of the school. What's wrong with the second one, the Leehigh, what's that?

Child: (faintly speaking)

Attorney General Bill McCollum: It's not only the name of the school it's probably the one over.

Child: The age is there.

Attorney General Bill McCollum: And the age is up there too, 15 year-old girl. You are going to tell a bad guy who you are. JAxbadbee16 what's wrong with that one? It tells the gender, it's a boy in this case and his age 16 probably. What's wrong with the next one? Hotandspicy, yea the guys will like that, but it's okay if you're talking to another if a girl is putting that up there and it teenage boy is looking at her maybe that's okay. But think about what the bad guy is thinking. He's going to say ah ha that's the one I'm going to go after. Same thing is really true of the others. Yes?

Child: It's provocative.

Attorney General Bill McCollum: It's provocative, it's provocative. That's a really good word. That's true of sassysue; that's also true of hot4hoops. Think about your names, think about your name. As cute as it may sound, you want to come across great to somebody else but the name itself invites trouble. So some of your names were find some of them weren't going to do that but don't give out your address, don't give out you school, and don't give out something that is too provocative. Because you're going to get the wrong person being enticed to whatever. Let's look at the next one, umm friend keep friend safe online. It's just a message that we have, and you know you don't want to get tricked into virtual relationships. It's really what that film was about you saw awhile ago. That young woman, that last film sometime its shown later in the presentation. It's it's really trying to say you don't want to get into relationship that you don't know who it is your talking to. Let's go on to the next one, next slide. Umm, what are these up here? What are they? They are videos games. That's another way that you guys can be communicating. How many of you in this room play video games online? How many of you play video games? Most, of you do. Okay, how many of you play video games online with somebody where you have a chat room where you're talking back and forth while you're playing the game? That's a pretty good percentage of you do that. Well let me let you that's another way the bad guys can communicate. A lot of times they will be on and they look for chat lines on

video games. So it's just a warning. Anyplace where go on the internet, it isn't just how about his one guys?

Attorney General Bill McCollum: You're a model cool; I'm a Chip and Dales' dancer. I also race speed boats, what's your sign he saying over there to her. You know, look what they really look like. That's what you could be talking to you don't know who you could be talking to, if you don't really know the person they could look like that.
