OPINIONS TO GOVERNOR.

OFFICES—HOLDING UNITED STATES AND STATE
AT SAME TIME.

Sir:—

Yours of 20th inst. has been received. I note your request that I advise as to whether or not a person, who is a County Commissioner, can also serve as Acting Assistant Surgeon and Quarantine Inspector for the United States Government. This office has passed upon this question under date of May 23rd, 1912, upon request of your predecessor for advice as to whether or not it is legal for one to hold the office of Pilot Commissioner and Quarantine Physician at the same time. You will find the opinion quoted at pages 76 and 77 of the report of this office for the years 1911 and 1912.

The rule stated and conclusion reached in that case are, in my opinion, applicable to this case.

I concur in the views therein expressed.
