Attorney General Moody's Week in Review - Jan. 12, 2024



This week, on National Human Trafficking Awareness Day, [I announced Tampa General Hospital as the first hospital in Florida to join our 100 Percent Club](#). Our 100 Percent Club recognizes businesses and organizations that commit to training their workforces to spot and report suspicious activity relating to human trafficking.

Multiple studies have found that more than 88% of human trafficking victims come into contact with the health care system at some point while being trafficked. So, if health care workers know the telltale signs of trafficking, they can alert authorities and help victims escape captors.
