

LEMON LAW ARBITRATORS SOUGHT

The Office of Attorney General James Uthmeier is seeking civic-minded individuals for appointment to the Florida New Motor Vehicle Arbitration Board. The Board is responsible for resolving disputes between consumers and manufacturers under the Lemon Law. Arbitration hearings are held online before three member panels consisting of a chairperson, a generalist, and a “technical” member with expertise in motor vehicle mechanics. While there is currently a need for technical members on the Board, applications from individuals of all backgrounds are sought. Hearings compensation is provided for each case heard and decided. Knowledge, experience or training in automobile technology, engineering, or the review and analysis of technical information are useful; a penchant for public service is required.
